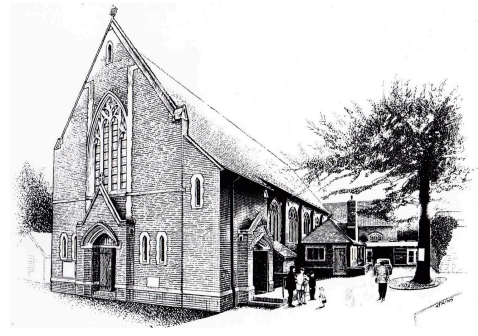

SCHOOL APPLICATIONS - CERT. OF CATHOLIC PRACTICE: School applications are changing, such that in most cases parents will be expected to supply a Certificate of Catholic Practice rather than school-specific forms monitoring Mass attendance. As the Bishops' Conference of England and Wales has explained in its guidance for clergy, "for the purposes of the Certificate of Catholic Practice, a person is a practising Catholic if they observe the Church's precept of attending Mass on Sundays and holidays of obligation." Where clergy do not have reason to believe that a family is practising the Faith to this standard, the Certificate of Catholic Practice will not be issued. Face-to-face interviews (during evening meetings) for parents wishing to secure certificates will take place in September; please do not submit requests before then.

AUGUST - MONTH OF THE IMMACULATE HEART: During the course of the calendar year Catholic custom has assigned certain devotions to particular months. August is associated with devotion to the Immaculate Heart of the Blessed Virgin Mary, and so we might pray in this month: *O Immaculate Heart of Mary, refuge of sinners, I beg of you by the infinite merits of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, and by the graces God has granted to you since your Immaculate Conception, the grace of never going astray again. Mother, keep me, a sinner, constantly bathed in the light of your Immaculate Heart. Amen.*
