

Thu 11th September - 12:30 Maureen Keech RIP PARISH PILGRIMAGE TO ROME - PREPARATORY EVENING: From 19:00 on Monday 1st September there will be an evening of prayer and preparation for our Jubilee pilgrimage to Rome at the end of the month. The evening will begin in the Hall and also make use of the church. Although especially organised for those registered for the pilgrimage, other parishioners interested in learning about the holy sites we will be visiting in Rome are very welcome to attend.

PARISH DEFIBRILLATOR: The Catenians have made the much-appreciated gift of an Automatic External Defibrillator (AED) to the parish. This has been mounted at the side-entrance to the church when passing through from the Hall, so as to be accessible to users of both sites. Please see the related signage in the church. An AED is a portable medical device that delivers an electric shock to a person's heart to restore a normal rhythm during a sudden cardiac arrest; the machine we have been given guides users through the process. Thank you to all involved in fundraising for, and procuring, this valuable piece of equipment.

CHOIR & ORGAN LOFT: Our parish musicians are moving! They will be using the Choir & Organ Loft at the back of the church, which in recent years had become a storage area and has recently been cleared. This will free up the side-chapel which, under the reconfigurations of the Covid era, had been set up for the exclusive use of musicians. The new arrangement should relieve pressure on seating (and reduce numbers standing) at major liturgies, such as during Christmas and Holy Week. Many thanks to the PMG leadership who have since last year assisted in preparations for the move. Those ascending the stairs are reminded to ensure that they use the safety handrail provided at all times; subject to the required diocesan permission being granted, a further handrail will be fitted in the near future for the comfort of regular users.
