

Pope Leo's New Apostolic Exhortation, DILEXI TE:

Pope Leo XIV has released his Apostolic Exhortation *DilexiTe* ("I have loved you"). The first major magisterial document of his pontificate, it is a continuation of a text begun by his immediate predecessor, just as Pope Francis completed Pope Benedict's encyclical *Lumen Fidei*.

Pope Leo's message sees the love of Christ incarnated in love for the poor - by caring for the sick, opposing slavery, defending women who experience exclusion and violence, making education available, charitable giving, and more.

OCTOBER - MONTH OF THE HOLY ROSARY: In October we are reminded of the value of praying the Holy Rosary. At his General Audience of 1st October Pope Leo addressed English-speaking faithful, saying, "As we begin the month dedicated to the holy Rosary, I invite you to pray it daily for peace in our world."

INDULGENCE FOR PRAYING THE ROSARY: "A plenary indulgence is granted for reciting five decades of the Rosary in a Catholic church or in a family group, religious community or pious association. (A partial indulgence is granted in other circumstances.) The five decades must be recited continuously. The vocal recitation must be accompanied by pious meditation on the mysteries. In public recitation, the mysteries must be announced in the manner customary in the place; for private recitation, however, it suffices if the vocal recitation is accompanied by meditation on the mysteries."
